



KTM CUP – S3 : OFFICIAL FAQ (Updated)

GENERAL

1. What is the KTM Cup all about?

KTM Cup is India's largest one-make racing championship by KTM India, accredited by FMSCI.

Season 3 follows this structure:

- **Zonal Rounds (4 zones)**
- **Qualifier @ Kari Motor Speedway**
- **Finale across Amateur, Pro & Women categories**
Plus, a new **Duke 390 – Ride with Dani** experience category.

2. Who are the race experts behind KTM Cup S3?

Professional KTM racing trainers and Gusto Racing, with finalists getting an opportunity to meet the Race Director and MotoGP athlete Dani Pedrosa

3. Is the KTM Cup part of INMRC?

No. It is a KTM One-Make Championship accredited by FMSCI.

4. Are there CC-wise categories?

No. All racing happens under the following standard categories:

- **Amateur**
- **Pro**
- **Women**
All motorcycles are race-prepped and provided by KTM to ensure equal performance.

5. Who can participate in the KTM Cup S3?

Any KTM or Husqvarna owner with:

- A valid driving licence
- Valid accident insurance
- Required documentation

6. Can non-owners participate?

For Zonal Rounds, we can allow a rider to participate on someone else's behalf on furnishing a valid NOC certificate with signature of the original owner. Please note that a rider who is not the actual owner of KTM motorcycle would only be eligible to participate in the zonal round. If qualifies, he won't be able to participate in the Qualifying unless it's a blood relation case. **(Supporting documents to be furnished in this case)**

7. Do I need to bring my own bike?

No. KTM provides all race motorcycles for zonal rounds, qualifiers, and the finale.

8. Can I use my own bike?

No. Being a one-make championship, all riders must use KTM-provided motorcycles.

9. I'm new to racing. Can I still participate?

Yes. Zonal rounds and qualifiers include structured training sessions, classroom briefings, and guided track drills conducted by professional racers.

10. What do participants get?

All participants receive a certificate. Top performers advance to the next stages, and zonal winners receive recognition.

11. What do the winners of KTM Cup S3 get?

- **Meet Dani Pedrosa**
 - **Live MotoGP experience**
 - **Interaction with KTM Factory Racing athletes**
 - **Visit the KTM Motohall in Austria**

ZONAL ROUNDS, QUALIFIER & FINALE

12. Where are the Zonal Rounds held?

KTM Cup S3 is divided into **4 zonal rounds** across India.

13. Can I participate in any zone?

Yes, you may register for the zone closest to you — but **only one zone per participant** is allowed.

14. What happens in the Zonal Rounds?

- A 2-day racing and training format
 - Professional coaching
 - Timed sessions
 - **Top 20 riders per zone** qualify for the next stage (across categories)

15. What happens in the training sessions?

- Classroom theory
 - Track riding drills
 - Riding technique and racecraft
 - Personal mentor feedback to improve lap timings

16. Can I bring my own riding gear?

Yes — but it must be inspected and approved by the KTM training team before use.

17. Can I participate in multiple zones?

No. Riders may participate in **only one** zonal round.

REGISTRATION & PARTICIPATION

18. How do I register?

1. Visit the KTM Cup registration page
 2. Fill in your details and pay the registration fee
 3. Receive a confirmation email with slot details
 4. Report 30 minutes early on the event day for training + timed sessions

19. What does the registration fee include?

- KTM-provided race motorcycle
 - Riding gear (jacket, pants, boots)
D Ring Helmet and Gauntlet gloves must be brought by the participant.

20. What should participants carry?

- D-ring helmet
 - Full Gauntlet gloves
 - Valid driving licence
 - Accident insurance
 - Race inners
 - Personal water bottle & towels
-

21. What is the last date to register?

Until **zonal slots fill up**. Slots are limited and offered on a first-come basis.

22. Is the registration fee refundable?

No. The fee is non-refundable.

23. Can someone participate on my behalf?

No. Participation requires identity and ownership verification of the registered rider.
